Straight Street opened its doors and hearts to the youth of Laurens County in August 1994 with a goal to provide youth with social opportunities that were free from negative pressures of the world. It's a place were they know they will be treated with respect and that they are expected to treat others respectfully. There may be as few as 10-15 youth or as many as 90 on a Friday

or Saturday evening between 7pm to 11pm. We welcome all youth ages 13-19. They come to have a good time with their friends with activities of Basketball, Air Hockey, Pool, Video Games or to just sit and talk. But it's not just about fun and games there's also Straight Talk each night which is time spent sharing a Christian message through a testimony or entertainment given by the Director, his wife or sometimes even a coach or

player from a local team.

Having to be closed for 15 months meant very little contact with the youth and their families. Our Director was able to contact some by phone calls which let them know we were still there for them, just at a distance.  Our Board of Directors also were contacted monthly on the status of the Center and Youth. In March 2021 we begin some of our scheduled Board meetings, observing DHEC requirements of Mask and Social Distancing.  Being closed effected our outreach in the community to youth and to supporters which also effected Financial support of the Center and it's efforts to be there for the youth of Laurens County.  When reopening in June 2021 the young people were so thankful for again having a place to go to on Friday and Saturday evenings. Our Board of Directors along with the Executive Director also very thankful for again being able to minister to the youth and their families. As some stated, "that's what we're here for".  3. We have volunteers from local churches that come Friday and Saturday evening, giving their time to be a part of the Center and it's ministry. This gives them the opportunity to learn more about youth of Laurens County and how as a volunteer at the Center they're making a positive impact on these young peoples' lives.
