DEFINITION

Under occasional supervision from the Deputy Assessor, appraises real estate for the County to accurately calculate property taxes, which involves conducting fieldwork to gather information, completing appropriate

documentation, and performing related office work.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

Licensed as an Appraiser for the State of South Carolina or must be obtained within two (2) years of appointment

to this class.
